Rewriting the community legal documents.


The next Board meeting will be March 21.

Imagine guiding your friends to Willowbend by saying "Just turn at the Take 5 oil change on the corner and go to the stop sign..." Imagine the business pictured above facing Tamiami Trail (41) but having both its entrance and exit on Habitat Blvd. Imagine 10 parking spaces associated with that oil change business. Imagine another building behind the oil change -- a 2-3 story building designated as office/retail space with 25 parking spaces. Imagine a small retention pond east of that "office" building. Imagine passing all this before you reach our Willowbend entrance sign!

The landowner of the parcel # 0155120008, known as 1401 S. Tamiami Trail, has requested a zoning change in order to develop it into not one, but TWO businesses. Think traffic concerns! Think noise! Think lights! Think signage! Think environment! Think nature (eagle perch on tall pine tree)! It is important to let your voices be heard if you oppose this zoning change.

Here's what you can do:

Attend the Planning Commission Public Hearing (tbd)*

• Attend the Board of County Commissioners Public Hearing (tbd)* This is the meeting when the County Commissioners will decide whether or not to issue the zoning change. It's a 6- to 9-month process from initial filing to final hearing.

Stay alert! Watch for notifications of the hearings.
*Public hearings require signage and postcard notifications provided by Sarasota County.

LMP Maintenance Requests

Willowbend homeowners will now have two options for requesting landscape and irrigation maintenance for their property.

Option 1 – Our current system is to email Sentry Mgmt. with their work order request, or

The call went out for tech savvy volunteers to take over the webmaster duties and Barbara Males taken over. Thank you, Barbara for volunteering!


Committee News
